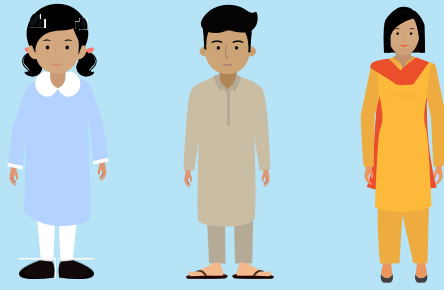


Covid-19 Country Level Analysis Factsheet

Discrimination & Public Attitudes towards Children and Families

24% of the child respondents felt the media portrayed children and young people more negatively than before the pandemic.

Giving Children's Views Due Weight

36% of the child respondents shared that the government was not taking their views into account when making decisions.

Access to Health Services

31% of the child respondents said they had less access to medical help since the Covid-19 pandemic, whereas 24% of the respondents stated they had medical facilities widely available to them.



Adequate Standard of Living

37% of the child respondents reported that the people they lived with had less money to meet their needs.



Education

80% of the child respondents reported that their education was better before the Coronavirus.



Play, Rest & Leisure

46% of the child respondents shared that they were better able to talk to their friends before the Coronavirus.



Access to Opportunities

41% of the child respondents shared that they had better opportunities to exercise before the corona virus pandemic.



Internet Usage

Almost a quarter (24%) of the child respondents use internet on a daily basis, 16% use it several times a day, 14% use it almost all the time and 8% at least every week.



Access to Internet

37% of the child respondents do not have access to the internet



Safety & Protection

33% of the child respondents felt safer at home/place of residence as compared to 19% who did not feel safe at home/place of residence.



Mental Health

51% of the child respondents mentioned stress as the most experienced feeling during the covid19 pandemic.
