Islamabad pilot child court is operationalization in June 2021.

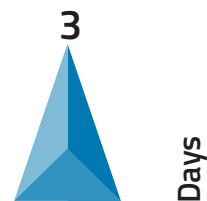
Case Disposal Rate

Case disposal rate in Islamabad pilot child court is 50%.



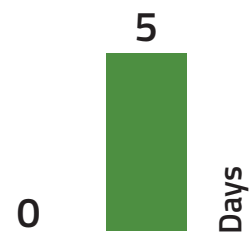
Time to Dispose of a Case

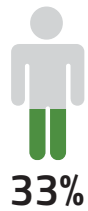

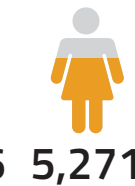
