# TERMS OF REFERENCE Animation Consultancy Vacancy Code: Animation-GDP-01)

**Location:** Remote

# 1. Organisational Context

Group Development Pakistan (GDP) is a leading non-governmental organization dedicated to promoting and protecting child rights in Pakistan since 2012. To create sustainable social change, GDP engages in child, cultural & gender-sensitive, eco-friendly, creative, participatory, and evidence-based initiatives such as legal and policy reform, stakeholder engagement, technical support, capacity-building, research, and service delivery.

On the occasion of this year's 16 Days of Activism Against Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG), we are launching a campaign focused on addressing the issues surrounding child marriage, which will continue through the next year. Despite legal restrictions, child marriage remains a prevalent issue, impacting the health, education, and well-being of young girls. The campaign aims to raise awareness of the harmful consequences of child marriage and encourages communities to value delaying marriage until adulthood.

# 2. Role Summary

We are seeking an experienced Animator/Graphic Designer Consultant to create three 2-minute animated videos to be disseminated across multiple channels. These animations will be produced in multiple languages—Urdu, Sindhi, Punjabi, Siraiki—and sign language to ensure accessibility for diverse audiences. One animation should be completed by November 30, 2024, with the remaining two expected in the first quarter of the next year.

# 3. Key Duties and Responsibilities

# **Creating Animation Videos**

#### **Duration**

Each animation should be between 2 minutes, highlighting the harmful impacts of child marriage.

#### Content

The animation should address the negative impacts of child marriage, focusing on health, education, and individual rights, in alignment with the 16 Days of Activism theme.

# Languages

The animation should have voiceovers in Urdu, Sindhi, Punjabi, and Siraiki, with English subtitles and a version incorporating sign language.

#### **Format**

Finalized in high-definition format suitable for online and offline platforms (e.g., social media, websites, live presentations)..

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# **Key Deliverables:**

Animation Video (2.5 to 3 minutes): Storyboard, draft animation, and final animation in required languages with a voiceover and English and Urdu subtitles.

- 2. **Phase 2**: Two animations for next year (2025).
